



Dear Resident of Filby,

First of all may I apologize for writing to you at this time, as I appreciate things are difficult at the moment, both financially and emotionally due to the Corona crisis.

My reason for my letter is to ask for your help, as Filby is again under threat of over development.

To put you in the picture the Great Yarmouth Borough Councils Draught Local Plan Part 2, due to be adopted this Year, has a housing allocation for Filby as Zero. (Policy ADP1).

This is backed up by Filby's Neighbourhood plan which was developed by the Parish Council in consultation with residents, which states that "residents felt strongly that there wasn't a need for further new housing ", (Policy 4.1). This document again to be formally adopted alongside the Borough Plan, both giving a clear planning policy for Filby to 2030.

Filby Parish Council are against any further large scale development outside the present and proposed development boundaries as defined in the Borough Plan.

As your Local Borough Councillor I need your help and for you to write in and object if you wish to the following applications that are outside the area.

1. 5 Houses opposite Poplar Drive 06/20/0132/F.
2. 6 Houses at Ormesby Lane 06/19/0079/O.

4. 18 Houses at Pound Lane 06/18/0631/F.
